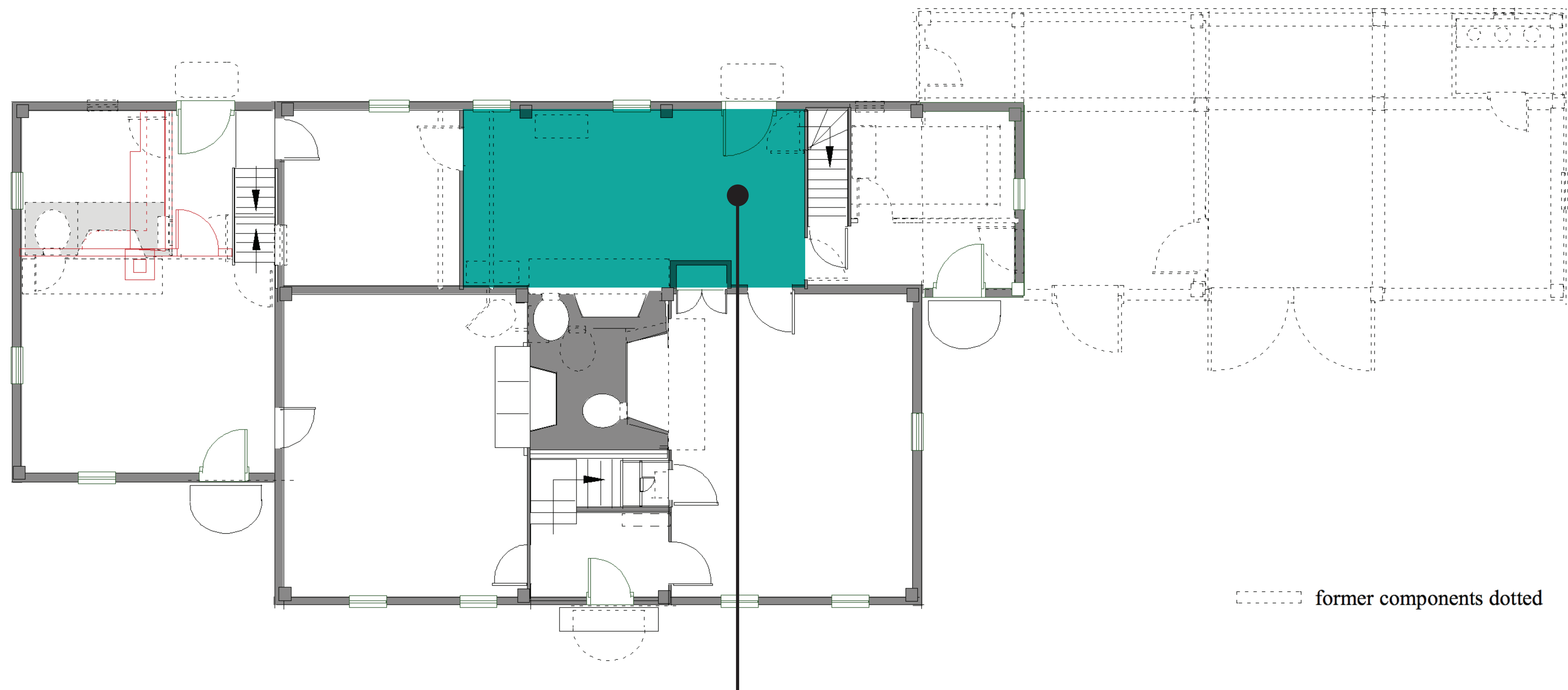


FIRST FLOOR THE KITCHEN

Use: Barrett's cooked here, Stephen Barrett nearly taken by British after entering kitchen from back door.
Original Features: Framing, board ceiling, most sheathing on three walls, door to cellar, stair to second floor, chimney.
Later Alterations: 18th c. exterior door altered, west side stair relocated to enlarge bedroom, fireplace updated 1800s
Restorations: Framing repaired, missing portions of sheathing replaced to match, first floor, fireplace and hearth
Furniture: Cooking implements among furnishings itemized in Barrett inventories of 1779, 1808, 1846, 1862.
Finishes: Original unpainted pine sheathing protected by later 19th-20th c. plaster removed recently.
